It is not a technical climb but will offer a challenging trek to one of the most beautiful views on earth, atop Mt. Kilimanjaro. There will be an optional safari to Serengeti National Park for those who wish to add that to the experience.

CAMINO DE SANTIAGO, SPAIN: SEPTEMBER 18-28

NICARAGUA: MARCH
